**MACPATCH HPB****SPECIALTY HIGH PERFORMANCE BINDER FOR COLD MIX****APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

**MACPATCH HPB** specifications will vary and are dependent on climatic zone, aggregate type and gradation, and seasonal requirements.

**DESIGN CRITERIA**

Mix designs should be formulated prior to initial production and each time aggregate sources are changed. Testing of final product is highly recommended to ensure a quality mix.

**MCA Technical Services** offers complete mix design services and product quality analysis.

**TYPICAL AGGREGATE SPECIFICATIONS**

Aggregate should be 100% crushed limestone or an equivalent meeting ASTM C-136. Recommended gradation and physical properties are as follows:
